♥ Fruit of the Spirit

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23.

The verses above are called the “fruit of the spirit.” Paul, the author of the book of Galatians, is referring to the Holy Spirit.

Father (God) - He created everything including you.

Son (Jesus) - God sent him to be your Savior.

Holy Spirit – Jesus sends him to live in those who believe.

When Jesus was baptized by John the Holy Spirit descended like a dove. Read Matthew 3:16. Jesus tells his disciples to wait for the Holy Spirit in Acts 1:4-8. After Jesus left the earth, the Holy Spirit lived in them and guided them while Jesus was in heaven. He, the Holy Spirit, comes to everyone who asks for salvation through Jesus Christ. When we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us, our character will be filled with the “fruit of the spirit.”

♥ Longsuffering (lōng'suf'ər·ing) n. Patient and forbearing endurance of injuries or offenses.

James 1:2-3 _____

♥ Gentleness (jen'təl·nəs) n. Mild disposition, tenderness, refined manners.

2 Timothy 2:24 _____

♥ Goodness (good·nəs) n. Pleasant, kind, proper, joyful, agreeable.

Psalm 23:6 _____

♥ Faith (fāth) n. Belief, trust. Faith in Jesus is essential for salvation.

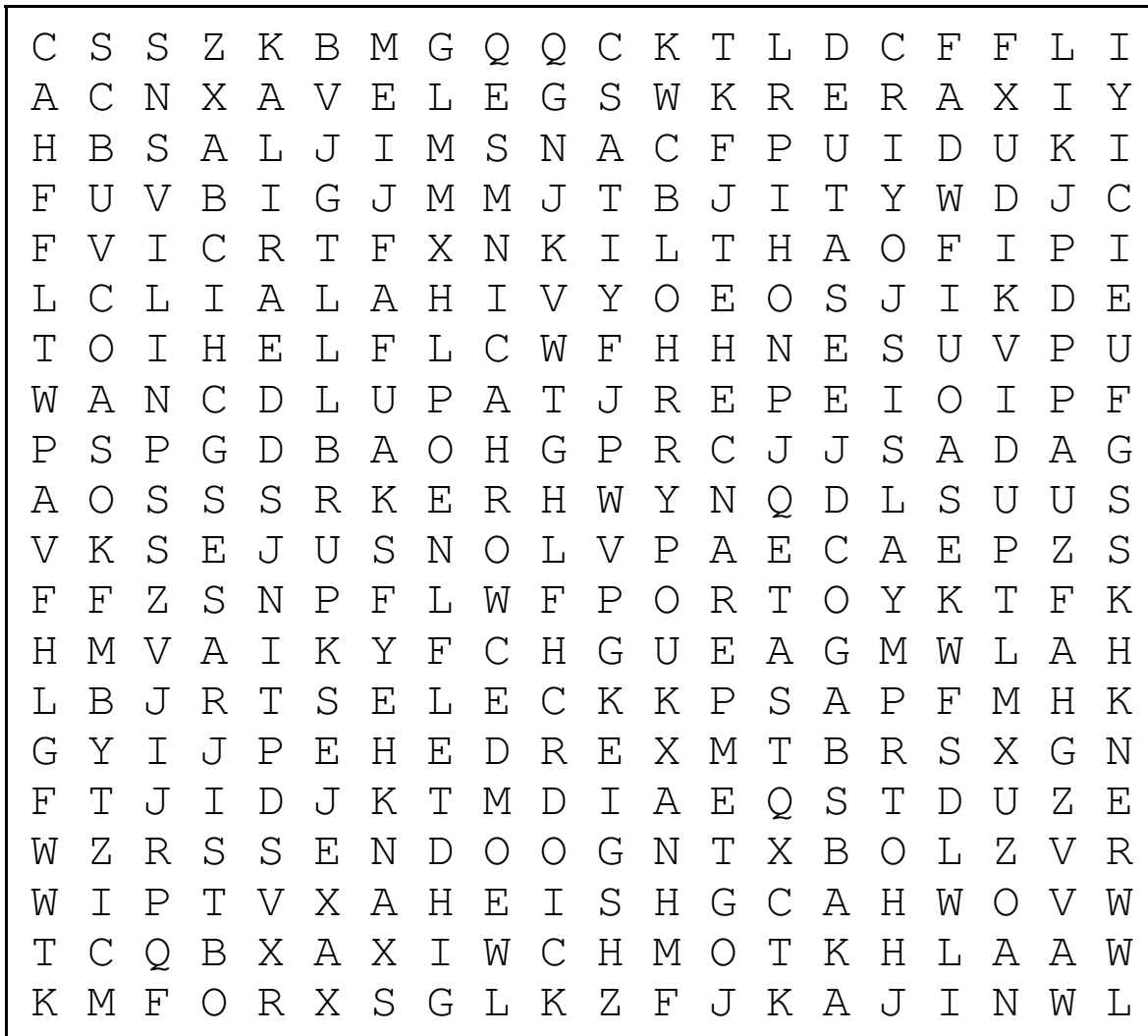

♥ The Parable of the Sower

Matthew 13:1-23

Jesus liked to teach in parables. A parable is a short story with a purpose of teaching a moral lesson. This parable is about a farmer that went out to sow seeds. The seeds represent people who hear God's word.

Some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up.

These are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

Some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth: But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.

These are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; and have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

Some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up, and choked it, and it yielded no fruit.

These are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word, and the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

Other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred.

These are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.

Will you be the seed that “**fell by the way side**” where the birds came by and snatched it away, a seed that “**fell on stony ground**” and withered away, a seed that “**fell among thorns**” and was choked, or a seed that “**fell on good ground**” who hears God's word, applies it to their life and bears good fruit?
