## Study the word's in The Lord's Prayer:

- ♥ **Father:** God is your heavenly father; he made you and knows your needs.
- ♥ **Hallowed:** (means holy) God's name is to be treated with respect and honor.
- ♥ **Thy kingdom come:** Jesus will come again & you will have a home with him.
- ♥ **Thy will be done:** Jesus is teaching you to ask God what his will is for your life. Your goal is heaven, not to stay here on earth.
- ♥ **Give us our daily bread:** Jesus is teaching you to ask God for your daily needs; physical & spiritual.
- ♥ **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors:** Jesus knows that you are not perfect and will need forgiveness for any offences to others. He also teaches us to forgive others who offend us.
- ♥ **Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil:** Jesus is teaching us to go to God when we are tempted by Satan.
